## What to See at MONA's 2014 Dark Mofo Festival in Hobart

The **Museum of Old and New Art**'s (MONA) winter festival, Dark Mofo, will return to Hobart in 2014 to celebrate the dark through large-scale public art, food, music, light, and noise. If the 2013 event was anything to go by, Dark Mofo will be worth a trip to Tasmania.

The program of art projects was one of the drawcards of the 2013 event, and will be again in 2014. Highlights include **Rafael Lozano-Hemmer**'s personalized light sculptures, **Yin Xiuzhen**'s wall of ice, and **Ross Manning**'s subterranean light installations, and the **Pat Brassington** retrospective, to name a few.

Music is also a big part of the Dark Mofo event which attracts some of the world's top composers and musicians. The impressive 2014 lineup includes **David Lynch**'s latest muse, **Chrysta Bell**, who will perform songs from her debut album; and **Diamanda Galás**, who will perform a new work entitled "Das Fieberspital."

"This is a festival of firsts; we are featuring an interactive public artwork on the waterfront, 'Washing River' 2014 by Chinese artist Yin Xiuzhen, the Dark Mofo Films program features national and world premieres, and we are hosting the inaugural Future Hobart 2014 public space forum with Vito Acconci."
